

FHCA Committees 2015

All members of the committee's will be appointed for a period of one year. The chair of the committee will report all activities of the committee to the FHCA Board of Directors keep minutes and records of the committee, and present a report at each regular meeting as to the progress of the committee. The chair may be a member of the Board. The chair of the committee shall be approved by a majority of the Board of Directors and will recommend additional committee for approval of the Board.

Safety & Well-Being – Promote the physical safety and well-being of the community, advocate on issues that will impact the well-being of businesses and/or residents, such as licensing, taxation, zoning, etc., and promote improvements to streets, common spaces, physical infrastructure and aesthetics of the Federal Hill area. Members of the committee will attend meetings concerning the licenses that will affect the atmosphere and climate of Federal Hill. The Board may assign other responsibilities.

Governance & Oversight – The duties will include strategic planning for the FHCA, periodic by-law reviews, and compliance with any filing concerning tax, IRS, etc. The Board may assign other responsibilities.

Special Events & Fundraising – The duties will be to raise funds for the operation of the FHCA. The committee shall prepare a yearlong activity calendar of fundraising events and promotions and recruit members and volunteers to ensure their success.

Membership & Nominating – The duties will be to promote awareness of the FHCA, increase membership in the FHCA, and prepare the slate of officers for consideration by the membership in accordance with the by-laws. The committee will identify potential future board members for consideration.

Marketing & Public Relations – The duties will be to promote Federal Hill in a positive manner by preparing promotional material, public relations material, and news release for the FHCA. Board must approve the information to be released.

Finance – The duties are to design and monitor the FHCA's annual budget/financial requirements and considerations.
